## Understanding your child's progress report

In year 7, students are split into 5 bands based on their SATS results, band 1 being the highest 20% of the year group, band 5 being the lowest 20%

This is their BASELINE BANDING

If your child's CURRENT BANDING is higher than their BASELINE BANDING, their progress is ABOVE where we expect them to be



After each assessment, the year group is once again sorted in 5 bands based on the results.

## This is their CURRENT BANDING

If your child's CURRENT BANDING is lower than their BASELINE BANDING, their progress is **BELOW** where we expect them to be

If your child's CURRENT BANDING is the same as their BASELINE BANDING, their progress is **ON** target

## Your child's attitude to learning is then scored out of 4 for the following:

Behaviour: How focused your child is in lessons & class participation
Classwork: How well your child presents & completes work within lessons
Independent Study: Completion of homework set by lesson.





Please note for KS3 Independent Study is only set for English, Maths & Science
