Consent to attend

Clothing

Students can be in their own clothes for the trip as long it is appropriate for the theatre.

Food

Pupils will need to bring their own lunch, however if they are entitled to free school meals we will be providing a pack up for them.

Medical/Dietary Needs

We will use the information previously provided on the school's Arbor system in relation to medical conditions or dietary requirements so please check the Arbor app to ensure that these are up to date, along with any contact telephone numbers in case we should need to contact you during the trip.

Students requiring an inhaler or emergency rescue medication such as EpiPens should ensure that they bring their own medication and carry it with them at all times.
