Dear Parents and Guardians,

This is a reminder that when students return to school after the Easter holidays, they must be in full school uniform. This includes:

- Wearing the correct colour tie
- School shoes (no trainers or boots – please refer to the school website for pictures of acceptable footwear)
- No fake nails or nail varnish
- No jewellery (including earrings / bracelets / nose studs)
- No frilly or fluffy socks
- Girls who choose to wear skirts we advise they should also wear tights
- No Flared trousers – trousers must be tailored fit
- Blazers must be always worn when walking around the school building
- No coats can be worn inside the school building

If a student returns after Easter without the correct uniform, parents will be asked to come in to support and ensure their child is dressed appropriately. Any jewellery worn will be confiscated and handed to the Year Team or reception. Year teams will be conducting thorough uniform checks on the first week back.

To avoid any upset, we kindly ask for your support in ensuring your child is correctly dressed for school every day. The Academy is not liable for any jewellery that goes missing on site.
