Stockport County DRiFT Programme – 26th September 2024

I would like to offer your child the opportunity to engage in the Stockport County DRiFT programme (Disorder Reduction in Football). This is a pilot session where students who engage will provide feedback with the aim of improving the content and delivery for its roll out across the borough.

What students will learn about:

- Club/matchday procedures and legislations to keep fans/player safe
- Risks of exploitation within football
- Impact of acts of violence and disorder upon fans/player/local community
- Reducing youth violence
- YOS/Police involvement
- Positive role models

The trip details are as follows:
